IN POTTER'S FIELD.

Marin Will Bury the Chinese Cook of the Elizabeth.

SAN RAFAEL, February 26.—The body of Ah Hee, the Chinese cook of the ship Elizabeth, which was found on the beach, still lies at the Morgue. After the recovery of the body Coroner Eden telephoned to Chinese Consul Bee as to whether the Six Chinese Companies would claim the remains. The answer received was that a Chinese representative would be sent here to look the matter up. This morning the Coroner again called the telephone into requisition, and Consul Bee's answer was to bury the remains in the potter's field at the expense of the county, which will be done to-morrow.
