### **LEE SING WAT'S WIFE.**

#### **A Struggle in Court to Secure Her Landing.**

Consul Bee was before Commissioner Houghton of the United States Circuit Court yesterday morning in behalf of Leo Sing Wat and his alleged wife, who are seeking a landing on writs of habeas corpus. Consul Bee testified that he believed that the woman was the lawful wife of Lee Sing Wat, while Deputy Surveyor Fogarty produced evidence from Victoria to show that the woman was a prostitute and that she was brought here for immoral purposes. The case was continued until June 10:th to permit evidence to be secured in the woman's behalf, and she was released on bonds.
